
City improvement highlights for 2025 included the annexation of property west of town, the new pharmacy, Keystone development, cleaning up Lincoln Prairie park, new housing count in the Ogden school district is at 65, "Howe" park future improvements, Fire truck purchase to replace the old one, Fareway traffic is increasing, Ogden Total Fitness and Hammertime Fitness opening up on Walnut Street, seven spec homes with workforce tax credits under construction, working on building codes and building inspections, better TIF understanding, and starting to stream council meetings.

Issues that continue to need improvements are properties need cleaned up downtown and residential, sidewalks need upgrades in the business district, finding a place for a burn pile, community center repairs and upgrades, future of Fun Days, Housing developments with over 55 only and rentals, small employers are needed.

Brenda Dryer will update our strategic plan and get the report back to the council soon.
